Materials List, if drawing:

Drawing Paper, Pad or Board of choice

Pencils (charcoal soft, med, hard or graphite 2H, H, HB, 2B) or Pastels

Kneaded eraser

Hard plastic or pink pearl eraser

Mirror

Materials List, if painting:

Oil or Acrylic Paints -- Important to note: this is a very basic number of colors. Students may use any color palette they already have in their collection.

- Cadmium Yellow
- Cadmium Red
- Ivory Black
- Titanium White
- Ultramarine Blue
- Alizarin Crimson
- Yellow Ochre

Optional colors

- English Red
- Cobalt Blue
- Burnt Sienna
- Naples Yellow

Brushes:

- Nos. 2, 4, 8 Flat or Filbert Bristle brushes
- Nos. 2 & 4 Soft-haired brushes (sable or synthetic sable)

Supports:

- Canvas or canvas boards in varying sizes (no smaller than 8"x 10", or larger 12" x 16")

Additional Items:

- Mirror
- Palette (plastic, or butcher tray for acrylics)
- Drop handle palette knife

- Palette cups (water container for acrylics)
- Rags, or paper towels
- Ivory Soap
- Linseed Oil (for oils, not for acrylics)
- Turpenoid (for oils, not for acrylics)
