

### Watercolor for beginners material list

- A set of watercolors, as long as you have basic colors: Tubes or cakes doesn't matter.
- A palette or some white plastic plates
- Two containers for water
- A cheaper set of Watercolor brushes (don't buy Michael's camel hair brushes by Artist loft...they lose their hair when wet) go for a nylon set of brushes instead.
- Tissues or toilet paper
- watercolor paper that we can cut to smaller pieces
- A white foam-board (no bigger than 12X20 inches) to tape your watercolor paper to, it is light and withstands the water excellently.
- Blue masking tape
